### Humphrey Model

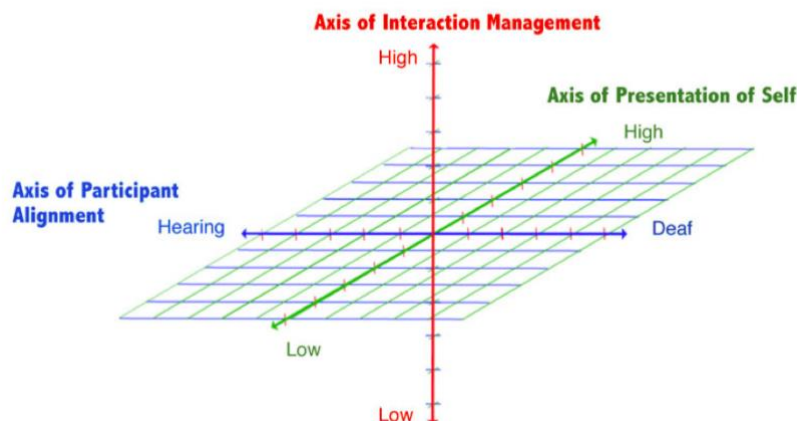
1. Consider how do you feel?
2. What are the meta-ethical issues?
3. Which tenet or tenets of the CPC apply to this situation?
4. What are your options?
5. What will you do and why?



### Demand-Control Schema (Dean & Pollard, 2005)

- 1) What demands exist in the situation?
  - a. Environmental
  - b. Interpersonal
  - c. Paralinguistic
  - d. Intrapersonal
- 2) What are the possible control options for those demands?
  - a. Pre-assignment
  - b. During the assignment
  - c. Post-assignment
- 3) What will you do and why?

### Role-Space (Lee & Lewellyn-Jones, 2014)



1) How will you align yourself with the participants throughout the assignment?

2) How will you manage the interaction? Does this represent high, low, or neutral interaction?

3) Will you speak out or act for your own behalf throughout the assignment? If so, where does that impact your placement on the axis of presentation of self?
