

What is critical thinking?



“Critical thinking is that mode of thinking –
about any subject, content, or problem –

in which the thinker improves the quality of his or her thinking
by skillfully taking charge of the structures inherent in thinking
and imposing intellectual standards upon them.”

(Paul & Elder, 2008)

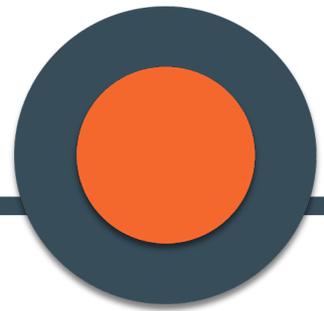
C.T., Culture, & Identity



How does culture & identity impact our critical thinking?



- Multiple perspectives – Deaf, Coda, hearing, Deafblind, Deaf & disabled, HOH, late Deafened, etc.
- Multiple perspectives – cultural & linguistic
- Multiple perspectives – identity:
gender/ race/ethnicity/sexuality/immigrant/age
- Multiple perspectives – intimacy & distance
(vulnerability & privacy)

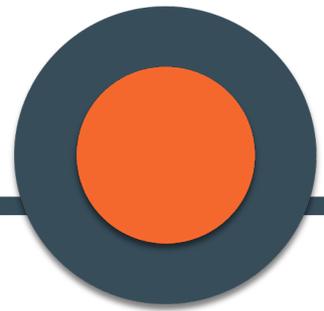
